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INTRODUCTION

On 1st June 1973, the Natural Environment Research Council formed the Institute of Oceanographic Sciences by the merger of the National Institute of Oceanography, Wormley, Surrey, the Unit of Coastal Sedimentation, Taunton, Somerset and the Institute of Coastal Oceanography and Tides (formerly the Liverpool Tidal Institute), Bidston, Cheshire. This report lists the publications and reports of the staff of the three organisations up to the formation of the Institute of Oceanographic Sciences.

The report is divided into three sections, Bidston, Taunton and Wormley, the locations of the component laboratories of IOS. Each section is further divided into two parts, papers and reports.

Papers are arranged alphabetically by the first author then chronologically by year of publication. Reports are arranged by report number. There is an index to all authors.

Some of the authors listed were not strictly on the staff at the time of publication quoted, but were closely associated with the Institute concerned or collaborated with a member of staff. Publications of a staff member before the date of formation of an Institute are not included.

A report listing the publications and reports of the Institute of Oceanographic Sciences from 1st June 1973 to December 1978 is shortly to appear.
