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NOTES ON FORESTRY COMMISSION CENSUS DATA, 1947 AND 1965/7

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Explanatory Notes

These notes and tables should be read in conjunction with the Forestry Commission report "Census of Woodlands 1965-67", H.M.S.O. 1970.

The 1965/7 census was not a complete enumeration but was based on a 15% sample. It is not, therefore, very accurate at a county level. At a regional level (i.e. about four counties) the total area of woodland is accurate to within 2½% and the major forest types to within 5%.

The figures available for private woodlands are for individual counties, and the Forestry Commission have kindly made available some unpublished data on private woodlands from their 1965/7 census. The figures for Forestry Commission woodlands are based on their Conservancies, which do not follow county boundaries exactly in all cases. Some slight discrepancies may occur in such cases, therefore.

An addition has been made to the figures for the 1947 census to allow for the fact that the census included only woodlands over five acres. The summary figures for England, Scotland and Wales given in the report on "Hedgerow and park timber and woods under five acres 1951" have been used as a basis for this. A proportion of the total area has been apportioned to each county, pro rata, according to the size of the county.

Acreages have been rounded off to the nearest 100 acres in all cases. (Because of this, totals may not always agree to the nearest 100 acres when the total is derived from the sum of un-rounded data).

"Mixed high forest" in the 1947 census has been allocated 50:50 to "coniferous" and "broadleaved" forest, for the sake of comparison with the 1965/7 census, which omitted the "mixed" category.

"Scrub woodland" is woodland in the ecological sense, but the trees are stunted and of little value as timber.

The figures available for planting and re-stocking of private and state woodlands are not strictly comparable, and are listed here separately. The figures for private woodlands are given on an acreage basis, and for state woodlands on the basis of the number of plants used each year. The species categories employed are also slightly different.

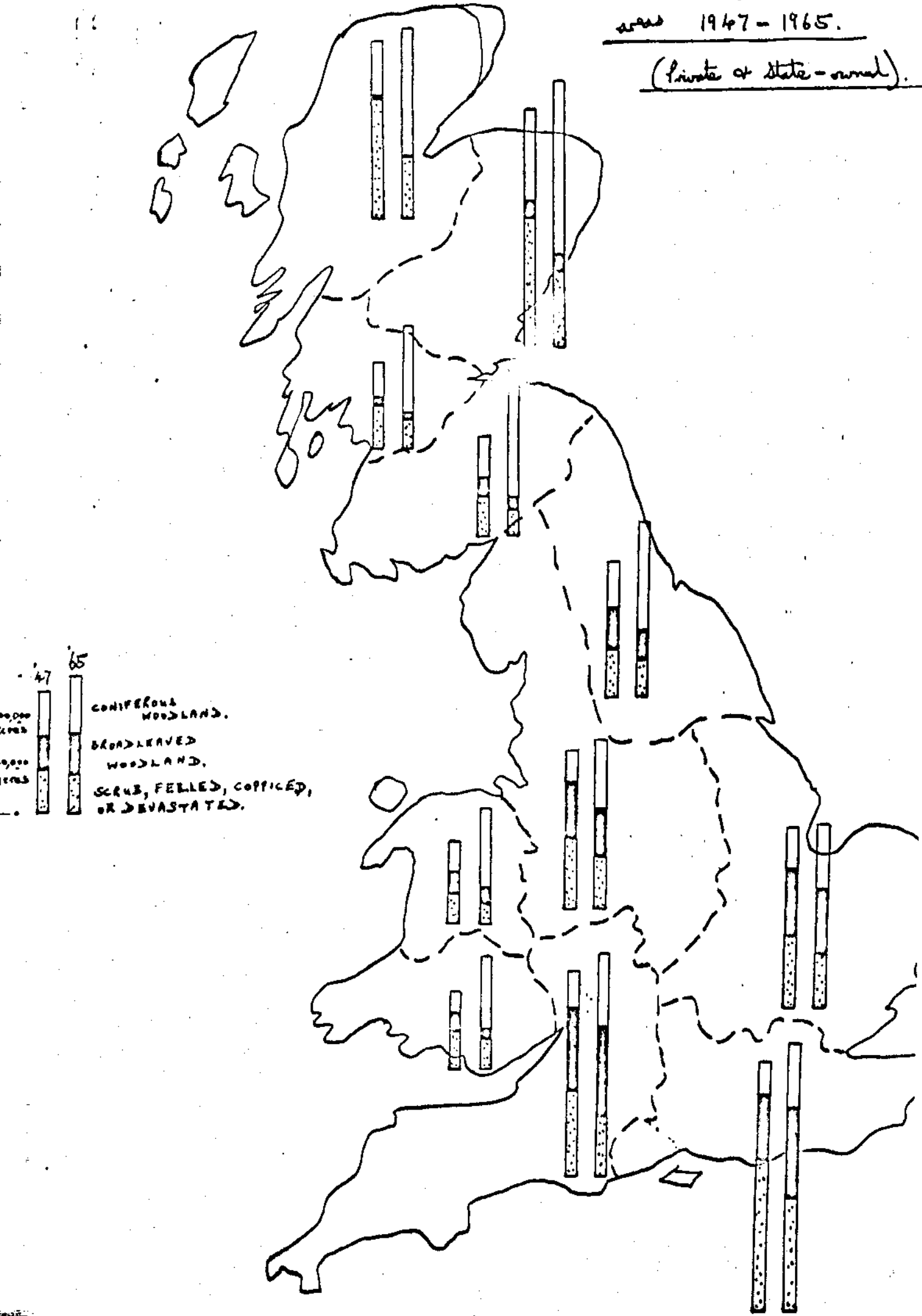

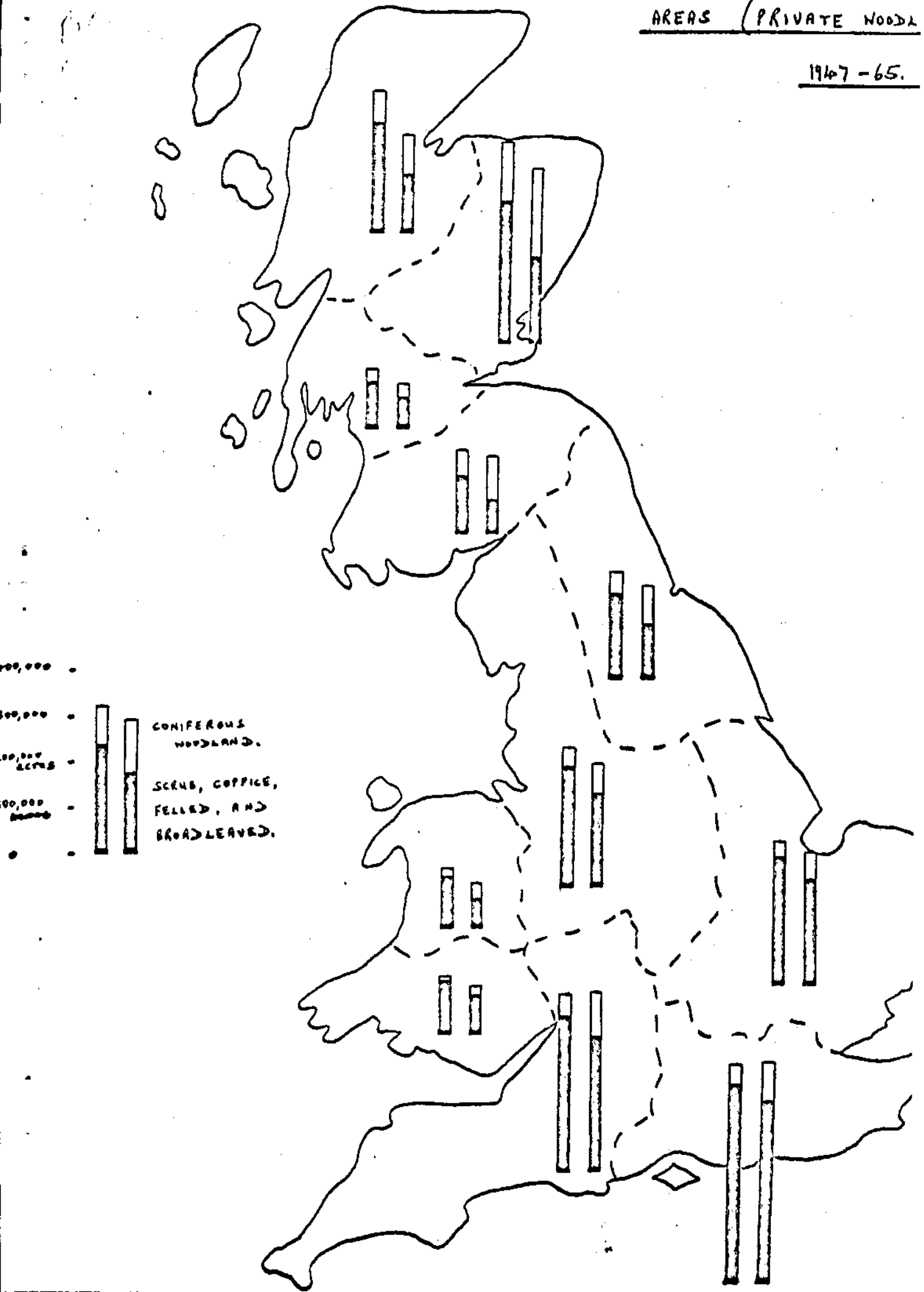

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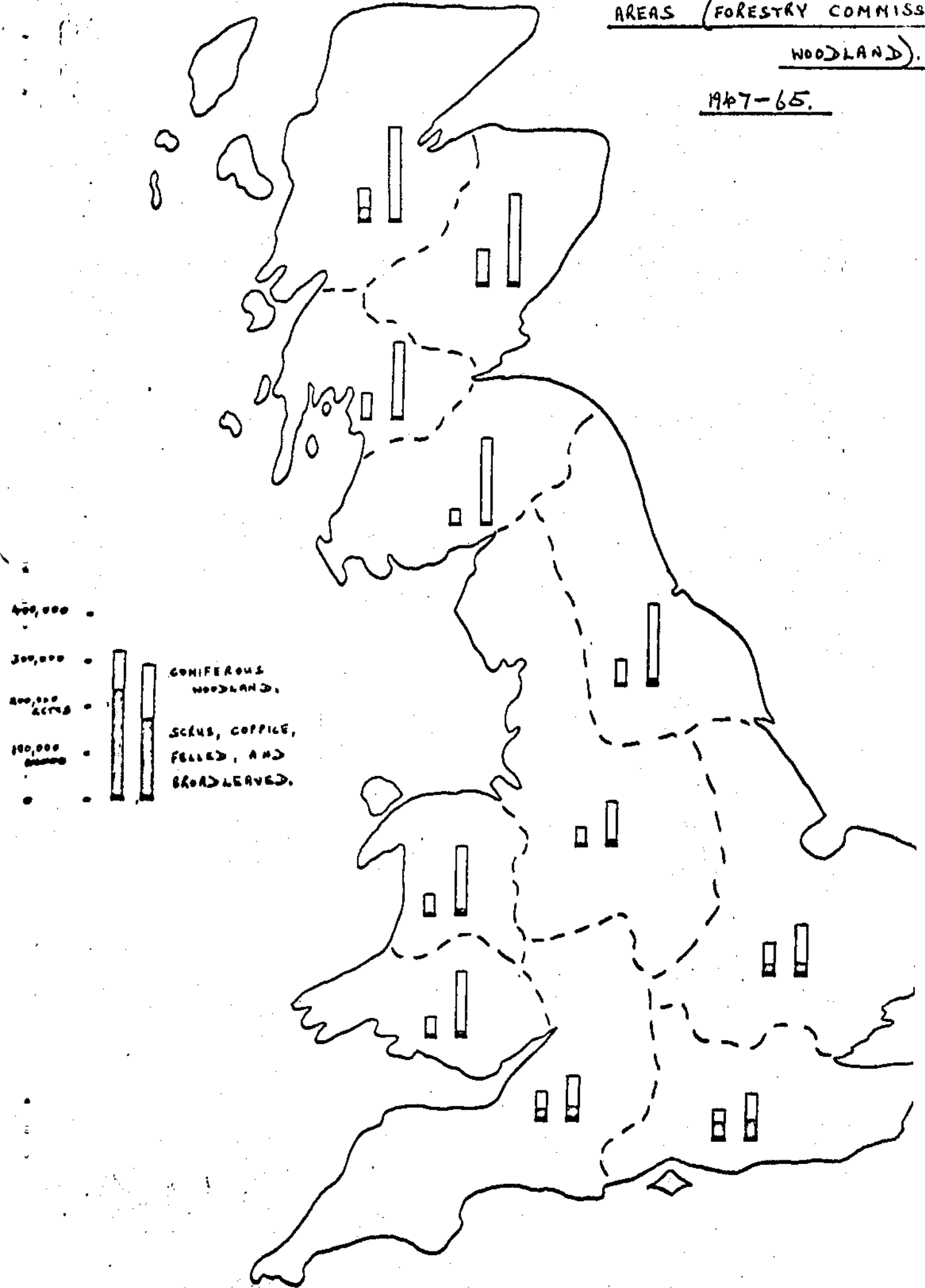

WOODLAND).

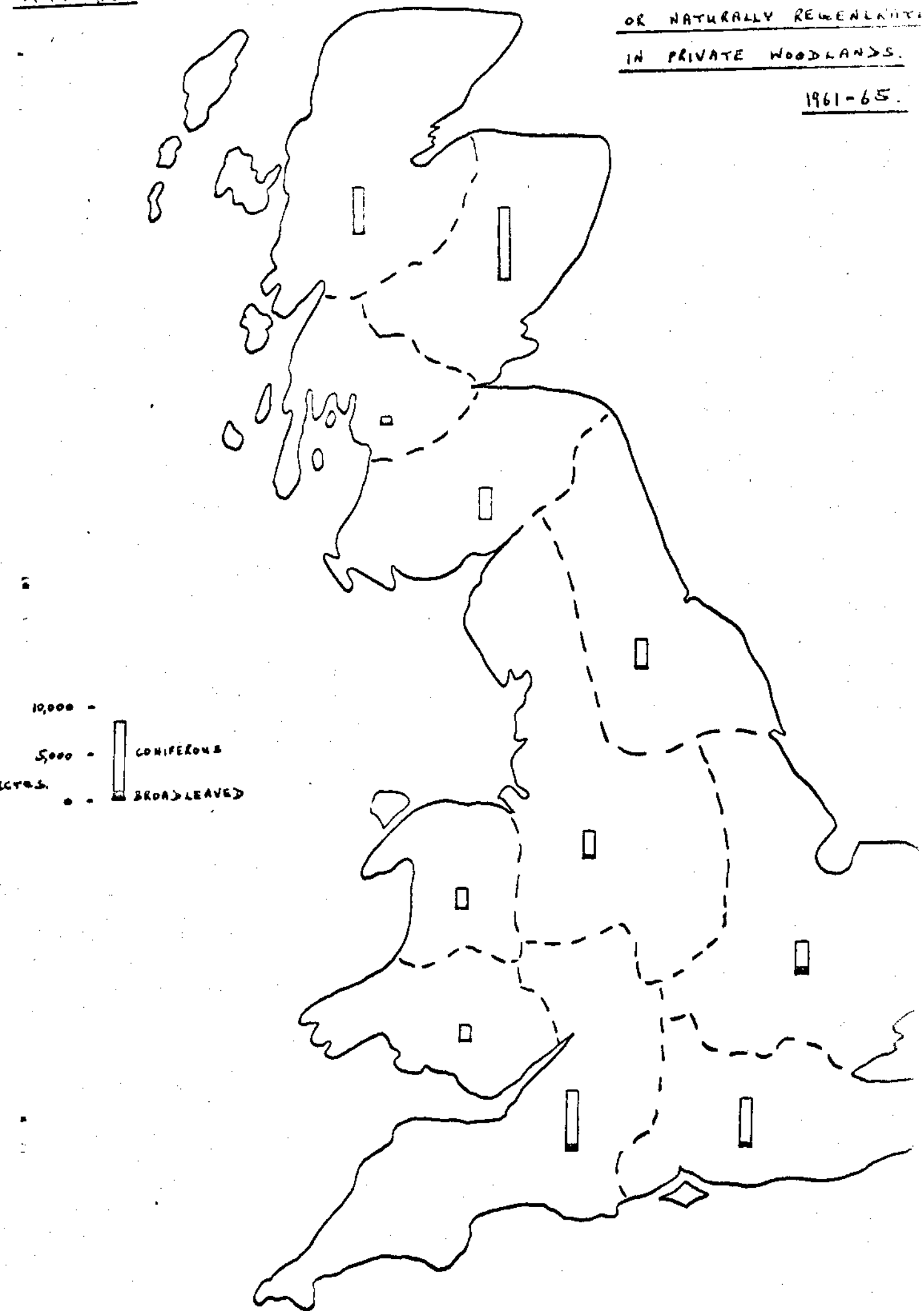

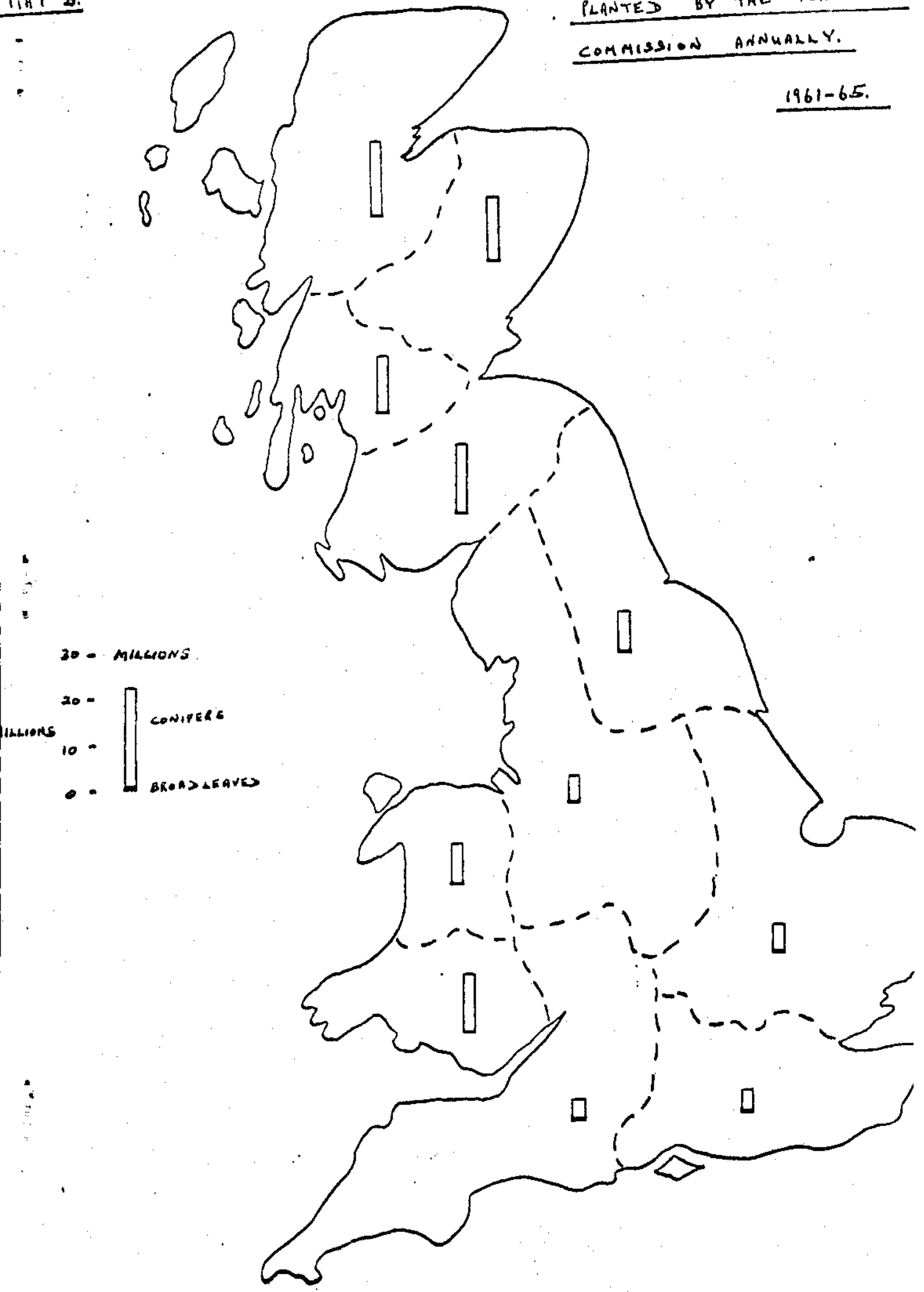
AVERAGE AREA PLANTED
